ABRAM and the Promises of God



You can **READ** about Abram in **Genesis 12:1-5, 13:14-16, 18:1-10, and 21:1-3**.



READ the **Picture Bible** pages 38-50.

God told Abram to leave his home and go to a land far away. It must have been scary, but Abram obeyed God—and God rewarded Abram by fulfilling THREE PROMISES that God had made to him.

What were those promises? You'll have to "decode" them by solving the cryptogram below!
