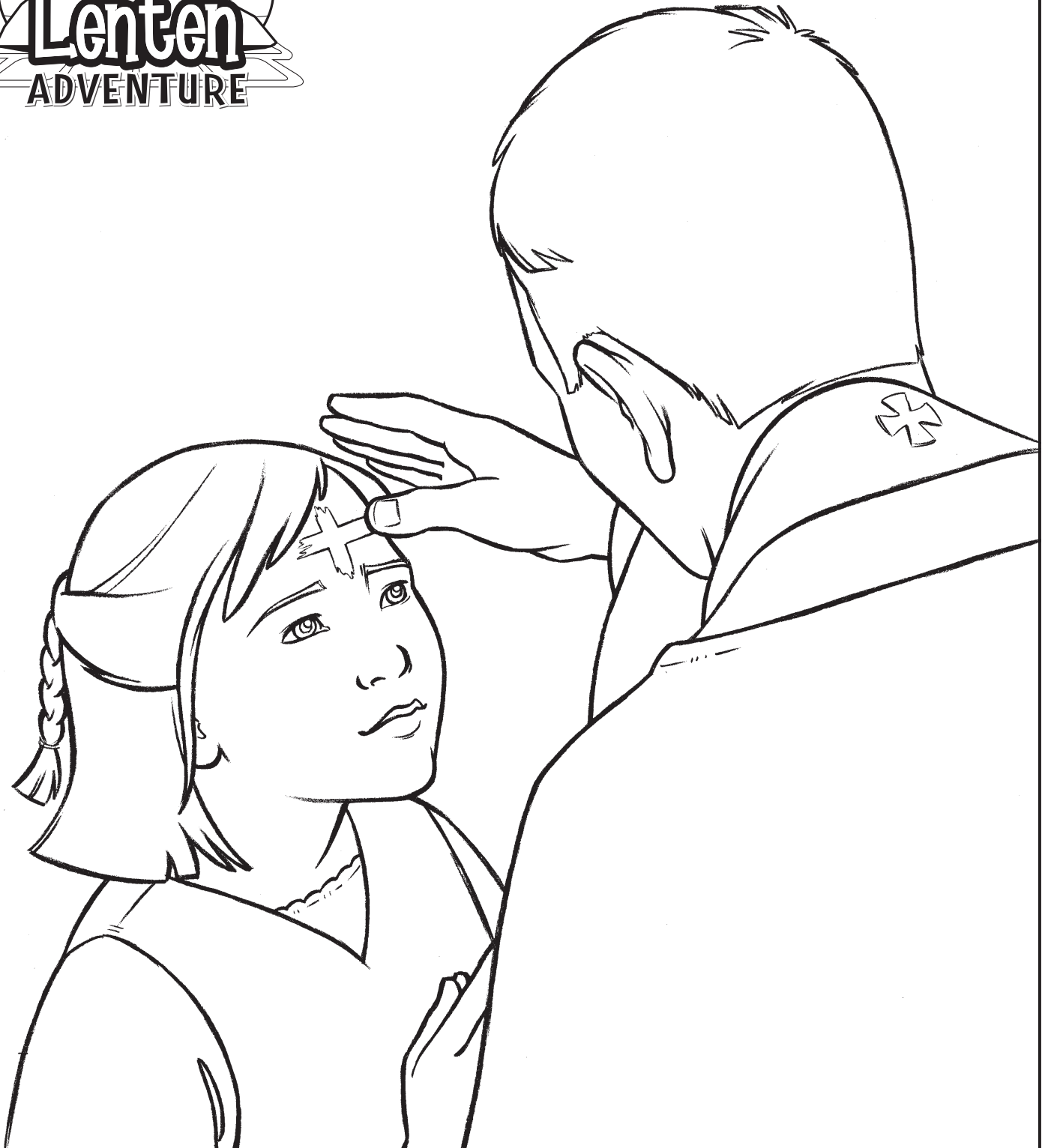




Season of Lent, Ash Wednesday
