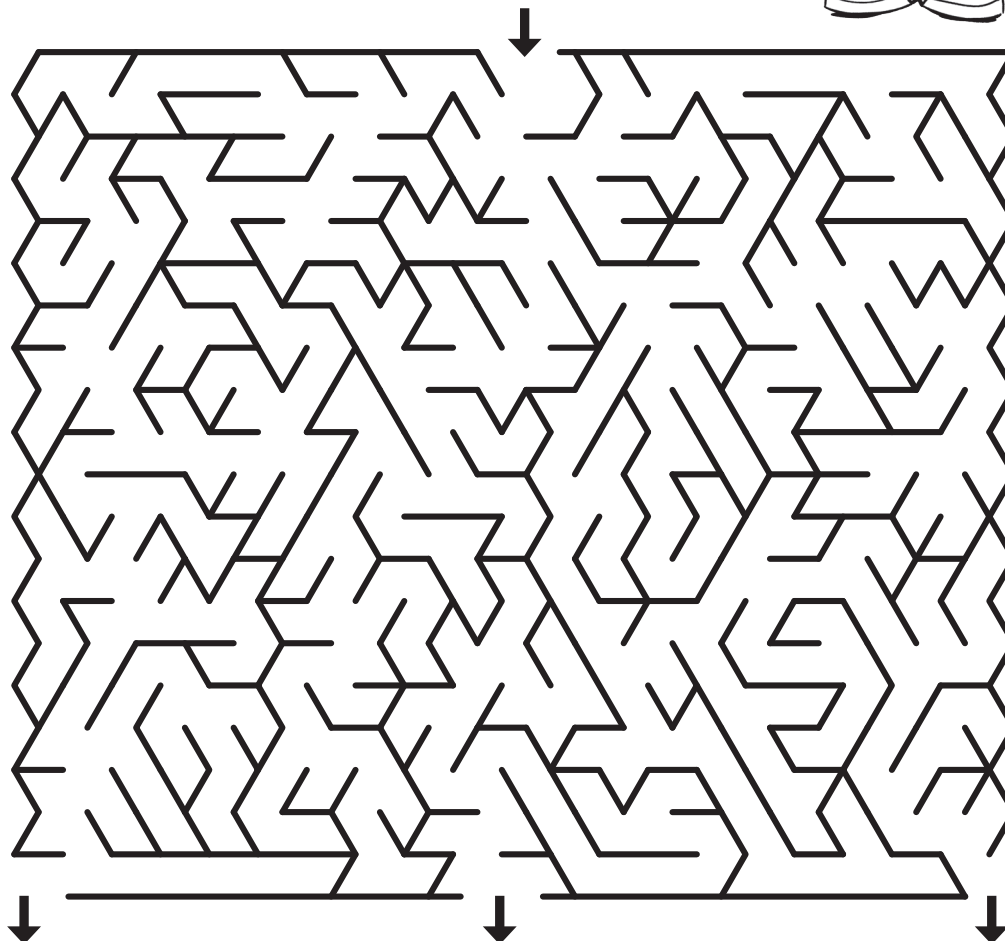
Many parishes begin to observe **Passiontide** beginning with the 5th Sunday of Lent, COVERING UP many things in the church with purple cloth.
