 - c. What should we do for those in each part of the Church (listed above)? Why?

- 5. Watch the "Craft" video and then make the craft.
- 6. Do the coloring and activity pages.
- 7. Watch the "Game" video and play the game
- 8. Watch the "Anointing of the Sick" video. Consider these questions:
 - a. When do you think you should call a priest to give someone the Anointing of the Sick?
 - b. Why do you think Jesus gave us a sacrament that would bring a priest to us right before we die? What other sacraments could we receive then?
 - c. Which other sacraments used oil? What other time in the <u>old</u> Kingdom of David was oil used?
 - d. BONUS REVIEW: What sacraments require a priest? Which a bishop? Which a deacon?
- 9. Have older children dig deeper by reading these Bible verses to identify some of the key lessons noted:
 - a. Mk 6:12-13 anointed with oil many sick, cured them
 - b. James 5:14-15 presbyters pray over sick, anoint, sins forgiven
 - c. Tobit 12:12 angel presents prayer of people to God

- d. Ephesians 6:18-19 make supplication for all the saints and for me

- f. Rev 5:8 angel offers prayers of the holy ones to God
- g. Wisdom 3:1-6 the souls of the just are in the hands of God
- h. Rev 20:4 saw the souls of those who were killed

- j. Rev 6:9-11 martyrs in heaven want earthly vindication






